## 1. Purpose

#### 2.1 Situation

#### 2.2 Background

The Board Model Standing Orders advises that Board meeting papers will include the minutes of committee meetings which the relevant committee has approved. To ensure that there is no delay in reporting from committees this paper provides a timely update on key items from committees.

### 2.3 Assessment

Key items agreed by Committee are noted below. Identification of organisational risks, stakeholder considerations and other impacts were included in papers to the Committee.

- Members received updates on the Delayed Discharge Performance Indictors and Diagnostics Internal Audit reports. The committee were assured by the level of work taking place to complete the various audit recommendations.
- The committee received the Strategic Risk Register and discussed the various risks aligned to the Performance Governance Committee and the differences between strategic and operational risks considered.
- The CNORIS Annual Report for 2021/22 was shared with members noting that national settlements were £109 million. In light of the increased costs, the NHS Ayrshire & Arran budget increased to £4.36 million with an extra £860k cost pressure being funded in 2023/24.
- Various financial and performance related reports were presented and scrutinised by the committee.
- Members received the planned Budget Setting Process for 2024/25. The proposed timetable was approved by the committee.
