1. Purpose

2. Report summary

2.1 Situation

This report provides information to Board Members on key items discussed within the Governance Committee's remit, in order to provide assurance to the Board that those matters have been identified and are being addressed, where required.

2.2 Background

2.3 Assessment

Key items discussed/agreed by Committee are noted below.

• The external audit plan for 2023-24 was presented to the committee by Audit Scotland.

- The committee received the final draft Internal Audit Plan for 2024/25 which has been considered by CMT and the Integrated Governance Committee also. This was approved for submission to the NHS Board for final approval.
- Members reviewed the 2023/24 Internal Audit Plan and Progress report. Some delays have been reported in completion of the final audits for the year however the Internal Auditor is confident that all audits will be on track for the end of year opinion in May 2024.
- The committee received the Internal Audit Report on Capital Procurement and Contracting of NSAIS rated yellow – moderate risk exposure. Monitoring of progress against the recommendations will be undertaken by the Performance Governance Committee.
- Members reviewed the Internal Audit Actions Follow Up report noting the recommendations which remain outstanding. The recent focus has shown some progress in completing actions. Two red overdue actions however remain outstanding and the committee pressed for imminent closure or a full update to the next committee.
- The committee approved the Audit and Risk Committee Annual Report for 2023-24. This will be submitted to the NHS Board in May 2024.
- The committee received a paper on the annual review of NHS Ayrshire & Arran Registers of Gifts, Hospitality and Interests. This highlighted a need for some additional work to be carried out to ensure staff are fully aware of responsibilities in this regard and this is being progressed.
