### **Community Pharmacy Palliative Care Network** Supporting safe, effective and efficient provision of

palliative care in the community.

Although in most circumstances, the patient's usual community pharmacist should be the first port of call, if the medication is not available within a reasonable time the nearest network pharmacy should be contacted by the community pharmacist, patient's GP or District Nurse, to arrange prompt supply.

Within Ayrshire and Arran, there are 40 community pharmacies participating in the network. Opening hours of the palliative network pharmacies and the medicine list they keep are detailed in this leaflet. 12 of these pharmacies stock an extended list of more unusual palliative medicines (highlighted on list of pharmacies)

The network pharmacy service includes:

- Retaining a stock of specialised palliative care medicines.
- Advice and support on palliative care medicines to community teams

### Out of hours

There is a palliative care bag containing palliative medicines in each of the 3 AUCS centres.

Advice is available from Ayrshire Hospice 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at 01292 269200

### Key points

### Prescribers

For some medications or formulations used in palliative care, ampoule size and strength can be specific due to their volume, risk of precipitation and syringe pump compatibility.

Please prescribe exactly from the palliative care medicines list detailed on this leaflet to prevent unnecessary delays to families accessing medicines at end of life.

To comply with legal requirements, ensure that directions are written on the prescription and if a controlled drug (CD) that the quantity is written in words and figures.

If medication is urgently required or is for a JUST in CASE bag, please communicate this on the prescription or by phoning the pharmacy, annotate URGENT or JIC.

### Pharmacists

Establish the urgency of the prescription if possible, when it is handed in, and appropriately prioritise dispensing of the palliative care medication. If the medication strength or ampoule size prescribed is not in stock and not on the list, or there is an issue with legality of the script, DO NOT GIVE THE SCRIPT BACK TO PATIENT, contact the prescriber to resolve the issue. Families don't have time to waste chasing round for end of life medicines. Confirm recent opioid dose, especially if the prescription is for >30mg morphine or equivalent and you have no PMR history for the patient. Check that the dose increase is safe.
